Cover Assembly & Release Bearing Differences

Applies to ClutchPro kits:
KMB22002
KMB23003
(MERCEDES BENZ)

When fitting ClutchPro KMB22002 and KMB23003 matched kits to Mercedes-Benz please note that the ClutchPro cover assemblies and release bearings supplied in these matched kits may differ from the old parts removed from the vehicle.

Early model Mercedes vehicles were commonly fitted with a cover assembly which has a release pad on the diaphragm fingers. ClutchPro does not supply a cover assembly with a release pad as the release bearing operates in direct contact with the ClutchPro cover assembly diaphragm.

The ClutchPro cover assembly supplied in KMB22002 and KMB23003 matched kits has no release pad and is therefore supplied with a release bearing which is longer than the original release bearing in order to compensate for the lower cover assembly diaphragm finger height without a release pad.
