



FITTING INSTRUCTIONS FOR RYCO CABIN FILTER RCA270C.

VOLKSWAGEN Golf Mk 7





1. The cabin air filter is located behind the glovebox compartment. It requires the glovebox to be removed.







2. To disengage and remove the glove box compartment lift the plastic knob on each side of the compartment as indicated on pic 3 & 4 so the retaining lugs can be bypassed. Once bypassed gently drop the box until the retaining arm on pic 5 is visible then gently push down the the arm to disengage. Now the glovebox is completely disengaged and can be rested on the floor.



3. The easiest way to release the lid off the housing is with a small flat screw driver. Release the three clips in pic 6, use the screw drive to disengage the clips. Whilst doing that, hold from the middle section and slighly pull so that the clips do not go back in place. Slide up and remove the lid. Grab the filter and slide it out gently so trapped dirt is not spread around. Clean the area and fit the new filter making sure it is in the right air flow direction (refer to side of filter) and refit all components in reverse order.
