HOW TO INSTALL YOUR BOOST REFERENCE ADAPTOR

TOOLS REQUIRED

General mechanic tools

BOOST REFERENE ADAPTOR INSTALLATION

- Allow the engine to cool down before installing your boost reference adaptor.
- Locate the factory fitted MAP sensor on the right hand side of the engine.
- Remove the MAP sensor plug.

this screw is kept in a safe place.







• Gently pull out the factory fitted MAP sensor and place in a safe location.

Loosen the screw holding the factory fitted MAP sensor in place. Ensure that

- Install the boost reference adaptor, ensuring that the O-ring is not kinked while you gently push the boost reference adaptor into position.
- Secure the boost reference adaptor in place by using the original factory supplied screw. Be careful not to over tighten the screw.


- Install the MAP sensor, ensuring that the O-ring is not kinked while you gently push the MAP sensor into the boost reference adaptor.
- Secure the MAP sensor in place by using the supplied bolt. Be careful not to over tighten the screw.

- Secure a vacuum hose onto the nipple located on the boost reference adaptor.
- Use hose clamps/spring clamps to secure the vacuum hose onto the nipple.
- Gently re-plug the MAP sensor.
- Turbosmart recommends that you consult a qualified auto electrician.
- Disconnect your battery before continuing.
- Take the cover off the fuse box located behind the battery.
- Locate pin "F49" in the fuse tray. This was a *spare* fuse position on our test vehicle. Ensure that it is a 12VDC ignition switched output on your vehicle by using a multimeter.
- Crimp the supplied spade connector on one end of the supplied inline fuse.
 Insert the spade connector into the fuse holder. Ensure that it is secured in
- Insert the space connector into the fuse holder. Ensure that it is secured in position.
- Route your cable out of the fuse box and secure the fuse tray cover back on.
- Route the vacuum hose and the power cable into the vehicle.
- Turbosmart recommends using the grommet shown.
- Mount your boost gauge and connect the red wire to the power source obtained from the engine bay. Ground the black cable. Insert the vacuum hose on-to the boost gauge.

- Ensure that the O-rings are not kinked during installation.
- Follow supplied instructions to install the boost gauge.
- Any other problems, don't hesitate to contact your local Turbosmart dealer.
