If only the ball bearings are worn, the BEK kit is available without a shaft. This allows you to replace the damaged parts without having to replace the entire transmission unnecessarily – and save a lot of money. SYMPTOMS

- Strong noise development on the vehicle underbody
- Shocks and jolts when starting off (shaft hits the transmission housing)
- Breakage of the cardan shaft to the front axle differential



REASONS FOR FAILURE

- Porous / torn rubber sleeve in front of the joint
- Penetration of water, dirt and road salt leads to severe corrosion
- · Joints deflects => too much play

RECOMMENDED BY THE EXPERT

- Changing the internal cardan shaft joint with VAICO EXPERT-KIT+ V30-4810
- Minor repair solution for the ball bearings with V30-4810-BEK
- Then change the oil or flush the automatic transmission
